APPOINTMENT OF COUNCIL MEMBER

TAKE NOTICE that the Village of Hilton Beach Council has declared the office of a member of council to be vacant. The Municipal Act permits the vacancy to be filled by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office if appointed or by requiring a by-election.

The Village of Hilton Beach Council will accept applications of intent together with a resume from interested persons to fill the vacant Council seat. The applications and resume must be submitted to the Village of Hilton Beach Municipal Office at the address specified below or by e-mail no later than Monday, May 10, 2021 at 11 a.m.

Although it is the responsibility of the individual to determine whether he or she is qualified to hold office, generally speaking the individual must be:

- A resident in the municipality or is the owner or tenant of land, or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
- A Canadian citizen;
- At least 18 years old;
- Not disqualified by any legislation from holding municipal office.

Council meetings are normally held the 2nd Wednesday night of each month beginning at 6 p.m. Committee meetings and budget meetings are also held in the evening. If you require further details, please contact the undersigned.
